PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

With spring comes the excitement of warmer days! As we move through the changing seasons, we remind families that students should continue to dress appropriately for the weather, including wearing proper outdoor footwear and having extra clothing- in case of puddles and muddy spots.

Inside the school, Manie Musical is in full swing! Students are listening to and voting for their favorite French songs. This is a great time to explore Francophone music as a family- consider making a playlist to enjoy in the car, at home, or even during a dance break in the kitchen!

Students have been actively working to demonstrate safe, responsible, and respectful behavior on the playground. As part of our PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports), also known as SCP (Soutien au Comportement Positif), we introduced a school-wide board game where classrooms earned points for following recess expectations- such as taking turns, playing safely, and using recess equipment appropriately. Each time students made positive choices, they helped their class advance on the board game, reinforcing teamwork and responsibility. It was great to see students take pride in their actions and contribute to this school-wide activity!

This past month ÉAM had the privilege of hosting our first land-based learning day, Boozhoo Ziigwan. Students engaged in cultural experiences, including art activities, dancing, and learning about fires. It was a wonderful opportunity to deepen our understanding of Indigenous teachings while welcoming the arrival of spring.

With the warmer temperatures, we anticipate uneven surfaces and ruts in the parking lot. Once the ground has fully thawed, we will be able to add gravel to improve conditions. In the meantime, we ask for your patience and caution when navigating the area.

We hope that everyone had a fun and refreshing Spring Break, and we are excited to welcome our students back for the final stretch of the school year!
